- Marketed as the best thing to replace WPecommerce
- Developed by WPMUDEV
  - http://premium.wpmudev.org/
  - Themes, plug-ins, support, hosting
  - USD\$35 a month for support and upgrades
  - Free version available! :)
    - With less features :(

## MarketPress Pros

- Straight forward to install, just a normal plug-in
- Reasonable options for a free site with PayPal support
- Active community and support
- Relatively easy to understand and use
- Can pay once to get the premium version with all the features



## MarketPress Cons

- Have to pay to get support
- Websites are a mess and push you to pay at every opportunity
- While support was responsive they couldn't resolve a tax issue for Australian sites
  - GST is inclusive in prices by law in Australia
- Not as comprehensive or as "nice" as WooCommerce
- SEO experts and fill Google with their stuff





- Developed by WooThemes

  - Themes, plug-ins, support, hosting
  - Base package is free! :)
    - But you pay for each additional feature :(

- PayPal Standard Gateway Accept credit cards and PayPal payments
- Mijireh Checkout Accept credit cards via Stripe, Authorize.net, PayPal, eWay, SagePay, Braintree, PayLeap, and more.
- BACS, Cheque and Cash on Delivery Simple offline gateways
- Flat rate shipping Ship your items using a flat cost



## WooCommerce

- Free shipping Ship for free, or require a coupon to enable
- International delivery, Local delivery and local Pickup
- Google Analytics Powerful analytics, including eCommerce tracking
- Sharedaddy and ShareThis Let your customers share your products with their friends



## WooCommerce Free vs Paying

- Tonnes of plug-ins
  - http://www.woothemes.com/productcategory/woocommerce-extensions/
- Pay only for what you need
  - Shipping multiple addresses \$29
  - PayPal Advanced \$49
  - Tablerate Shipping \$99
- Can become very expensive very quickly



## WooCommerce Pros

- Straight forward to install, just a normal plug-in
- Reasonable options for a free site with Paypal support
- Active community and support
- Very "nice" and helpful design
  - WooThemes are integrated through Wootique
- Websites are clean and easy to find information



## WooCommerce Cons

- Have to pay to get support
- Paying for what you need sounds great, but can cost a lot
- Could not put individual prices for shipping
- Only supports Paypal Standard for free
- Images need to be the same size or the layout goes nasty
- Checkout interface is a bit messy (squashed)
